Annual Activities Report : 2022-23 Revival Foundation (REFOUND)

ABOUT THE ORGANISATION :

Revival Foundation (REFOUND), Wangjing, Thoubal District, Manipur was established on 20th December 1997 and registered on 5th March, 1998 under Manipur societies Registration Act, 1989 (Act 1 of 1990) vide Registration No. 215 as a district level organization. And, later in the year 2014 registered and converted as a state level organization on 16th January. The organization is promoted by a team of dedicated persons for the welfare & development of the needy people in the state. Since its inception, the organization has been working for the



welfare of the people in the field of Rehabilitation works, Vocational training and improvement of socio-economic condition of the downtrodden and needy people. The organization is recognized institute for providing VTC for the disabled persons under PWD Act, 1995 and the organization has been declared <u>"Fit Institution"</u> under JJ (Care and Protection of Children) Rules, 2012. The organization is also registered under 12 A of Income Tax Act, 1961.

OLD AGE HOME

Our organisation has been running an old age home & day care centre for olderly women at Sirui Junction, Ukhrul District which is managed from the own fund of the organization and donations from local youth clubs, well wishers. The home is getting support & co-operation from the village authority, clubs of the village & adjoining villages in running and maintenance of the centre. The inmates are mostly neglected and destitute. The inmates are brought to the Home by the local youths and village authority. During



the reporting year, the strength of the home is 25 senior citizens. The organization provides VTC to the inmates and beneficiaries for their extra income.

CHILDREN HOME FOR BOYS UNDER MISSION VATSALYA : CHANDEL DISTRICT

Our Children Home was established on 12th April, 2017 and has been running the home from our organisation's own fund for 23 orphan Children. However, from the year 2018-19, our home was given grant-in-aid from the Ministry of Women and child Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi under Mission Vatsalya for 50 Children. Prominient



persons like Chairperson, Manipur Chandel, officials of District Child Protection office, Chandel, Additional Superintendant of Police, Chandel visited the our home and donated food, cloth, playing materials to the children. During the reporting year, the strength of the home is 50 nos. comprising of children from the category of destitute, orphan, neglected, underprivileged children referred by Child Line and Child Welfare committee, Chandel.

CHILDREN HOME FOR BOYS UNDER MISSION VATSALYA : PHERZAWL DISTRICT

Our Children Home was established on 8th April, 2018 and has been running the home from our organisation's own fund for 21 orphan Children. However, from the year 2019-20, our home was given grant-in-aid from the Ministry of Women and child Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi under Mission Vatsalya for 34 Children. However, the present capacity of the children is 43 as much needy children have been given shelter as our home is the only home for



boys in the District. The concerned officials like CWC, DCPU, Legal team, Police personnel of the District are frequently visiting the home to address their grievances.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME TRAFFICKING OF WOMEN AND CHILD

Our organization conducted an awareness programme on Wome & Child Trafficking at Salemthar, Chandel District from 4th to 6th Sept. 2023. The Programme was attended by Prominient persons like Chairperson, Manipur Chandel, officials of District Child Protection office, Chandel, Additional Superintendant of Police, Chandel. Altogether, 65 Women and 57 school girl students attended the programme. Various topics were discussed relating to trafficking by the eminent resource persons.

SHAKTI SADAN

The Swadhar Greh (now, called as Shakti Sadan) has been running since 1st April, 2011 at Moreh Bazar, Near Moreh Hospital under the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi. During the reporting year, the centre has 30 inmates along with 9 (nine) dependent children from the communities namely Meitei, Kuki, Muslim, Tamil and Nepali. The centre provides free fooding, medical care, entertainment programme, medical free check-up. counselling services, vocational training programme etc.

HALF WAY HOME FOR DISABLES

The organization has been running a half way and short stay home for disables at Pallel Bazar, chandel District since the year 2013. The organization provided welfare service to 23 disabled persons by providing day care services and imparted VTC in Handicraft, preservation of dry fruits and vegetables. The home provides

vocational training in various trades for sustainable livelihood and job placement. The home is first of its type in whole of chandel District, Manipur. The organization engages qualified instructors and designers for further skill development, organizes workshop in innovative designs, marketing etc.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE

The organization has been running vocational Training Centre (VTC) for disabled persons since 2014. Training is imparted in 3 different trades namely zari craft, embroidery & toys making. The centre is run at Pallel Bazar, near Bus/ Auto Parking, Chandel District, Manipur at a rented building. The beneficiaries the based on selected are recommendations of the Chandel District Disabled Persons Welfare association, Office of the District Social Welfare

During the reporting year the organization conducted skill test for all the trades. Out of 50 undergoing trainees, 32 trainees passed the skill training and will be distributed passed certificates. And, the remaining 18 trainees will have to further undergo training for another session or till they are fully skilled in the respective trades.

SC GIRLS HOSTEL

The organisation has completed the construction work of SC Girls Hostel for 50 inmate capacity under the scheme of Babu Jagjivan Ram Chhtrawas Yojana, Ministry of Social Justice and empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi. Since the construction work has been completed, the admissions for stay have been started for the SC Girls studying in various schools and colleges in and around More, Tengnoupal District, Manipur.



TEMPORARY SHELTER HOME

The organization has been running a Children Home and Temporary shelter home for a capacity of 50 children home at Salemthar, chandel District, Manipur since the year 2005. During the reporting year i.e 2022-23, the home enrolled 50 children providing day care educational services. They are provided free food, clothing, education, counselling and other life skill education. The organisation is providing

PUBLIC LIBRARY & INFORMATION CENTRE

The organisation runs a Revival Public Library & Information Centre at Wangjing, Thoubal district, Manipur. The organisation mobilized and motivated the students, local youth clubs, women associations for encouraging the library movement in rural areas. The organisation highlighted the need and importance of library and information centre for well being of the society. The students were volunteered to donate their text books, guide books reference books after their final examinations. The centre has a collection of 6200 books which were donated and purchased. The library is opened to the public from 7 a.m upto 7.30 p.m on all days. The organisation has been trying its best to serve the community at large with all facilities.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR YOUTHS & DISABLES

The organisation have been running craft training centre at Kakching, Thoubal District, & Salemthar ST village, Chandel District, Manipur which is inhabited by the SCs. The craft centre provides vocational training on different trades like Zari Craft, Toys & dolls, Reed Craft, Cane & bamboo, artistic Textiles.

As a major initiative for socio-

economic upliftment of SC/ ST & Minority people in the state, the organisation has opened up craft training centre for SC populations at kakching Bazar, Thoubal District & Salemthar ST village, Chandel District, Manipur. During the reporting year, the craft training centre for SCs at Kakching, Thoubal District has 96 trainees & craft training centre for STs at Salemthar ST village, Chandel District has 77 trainees.

CULTURAL HALL

The Cultural Hall constructed under the financial assistance of Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India with a sitting capacity of 500 nos. is a boon to the local people and cultural artist. The people of Thoubal & Chandel Districts are benefited by the multipurpose Hall. The Hall is opened to the students, artist, clubs, women associations & general public for



organizing educational, cultural & social related activities free of cost. The local clubs, NGOs, Govt. Departments & other various agencies also use the hall.

DDRC, CHANDEL

Our organisation started functioning a District Disability Rehabiliotation Centre (DDRC) at Sinadam, Japhou Bazar, Chandel District from 10th August,2021. Our organisation has implemented various vocational training programmes under DDRS Scheme of Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt of India in Chandel



district. In understanding the number of disables and their needs, our organisation started running the DDRC, Chandel with our own fund to help the needy disables of Chandel District. The DDRC, Chandel got approved from the Ministry of social Justice & empowerment, Govt. of India in its meeting held on 30th August,2022. However, sanction is due till date.

HANDICRAFT TRAINING & PROCUCTION CENTRE FOR SHGs & WOMEN

During the reporting year, the organisation conducted vocational training courses for SHG members and rural women along with free adult education to 42 women at Wangjing S.K Leikai, PO-Wangjing, Thoubal, Manipur. The VTC programmes include fruit & vegetable preservation, handloom and handicrafts, mushroom farming, candle making, agarbati making etc.



The programme is conducted in collaboration with the local volunteers and educated youths. The condense course was started from 18th February, 2008 and continuing till the reporting year in various rural areas of Manipur. The condense course will provide free education for up to class VIII standard. The candidates who clear the class VIII standard will be given further education to clear the Xth standard through the open schooling. During the reporting year the organization conducted final test for the adult women and found that at least 85% could read & write.
